

**Highclere Welfare Charities – 2020 Report to Highclere Annual Parish Meeting**

**Charities**

Highclere Welfare Charities is made up of two charities:

Relief in Need and Relief in Sickness.

**Trustees:**

Highclere Welfare Charities has a board of five trustees. The Rector is ex-officio and chair. There are two nominative trustees appointed by the Parish Council for a term of four years and two co-optative trustees appointed by the trustees for a term of five years. In normal circumstances the trustees meet once a year each November to conduct the business of the charities and agree disbursements.

**Finance**

Due to the pandemic the trustees did not meet in 2020 (a virtual meeting was not accessible for all trustees) and so the accounts have not formally been approved as yet.

The annual combined net income in 2020 was c.£270.

The Trustees will meet when an in-person meeting is possible.

**Disbursements in 2020:**

Again due to not meeting a full review of disbursements could not take place. However the trustees agreed by e-mail to give 3 Christmas food gifts to individual beneficiaries and to review matters when a meeting is possible.
